Grant in Aid Information

Closing Dates for Grants in Aid rounds are 30 March and 31 October annually. The two QUT Grants-in-Aid Schemes are for Overseas Study and Conference. To be eligible to apply for financial support research higher degree students must:

- have confirmed candidature (if enrolled in the doctoral program),
- be receiving substantial funding support from the relevant faculty, and
- not be QUT full-time or fractional staff (for whom other forms of financial support are available).

The schemes provide contribution towards a return economy airfare to the destination nominated. They will not provide living expenses, land travel content, or conference registration, neither will the grant cover a round-the-world airfare.

Applicants who have not received an award previously will be given priority for awards. Retrospective applications can not be considered.

The budget for the scheme is strictly limited and competition for the Grants-in-Aid is keen.
