



CUT-OFF DATES DECEMBER 2007 (Education) FEBRUARY 2008 CEREMONIES

STUDENT THESIS SUBMISSION TO RSC: December ceremony

To be eligible for the December graduation ceremony the Research Students Centre (RSC) need to receive **the final bound approved thesis** plus electronic copy and citation (where applicable), for all **Education** higher degree research students by **30 November 2007**.

February ceremony

The Research Students Centre (RSC) needs to receive **the final bound approved thesis** plus electronic copy and citation (where applicable), for all higher degree research students by **17 December 2007**. (This also refers to the Education graduands who do not meet the February criteria.)

This will ensure that the documents are approved in time for inclusion in the conferral list for graduation. It is recommended the thesis be submitted to the Faculty two weeks prior to this to meet the RSC cut off.

NOTE

Students who submit their final thesis into the Research Students Centre after the RSC cut-off date **will not** be eligible to graduate until the next round of ceremonies!

CONFERRAL OF DEGREES

Doctoral graduands may soon be able to officially use the title "Dr" once the Dean of Graduate Studies has approved awarding the degree. For the moment doctoral graduands need to wait for the relevant ceremony until the title can be applied. Attendance at the ceremony is not compulsory.
