Applications are invited from appropriately qualified individuals for an Australian Research Council (ARC) funded Australian Postgraduate Award Industry (APAI) PhD scholarship.

The project:

Quality of life and well being are essential to maintaining a healthy and socially-engaged population. This project takes an innovative trans-disciplinary approach in addressing the national research that identifies the attributes of communities that foster or inhibit social engagement. The outcomes of the project will inform policy makers, planners and service deliver organisations about ways to identify, improve or maintain safe housing, transport and community environments for the benefit of all Australians.

The Scholarship:

The award is based in Brisbane, Queensland at QUT. There is a stipend of \$26,669 (tax free and indexed annually) for up to three years, full-time study. Reimbursement of relocation expenses may be payable to the successful applicant.

Application Criteria:

Applicants must be Australian or NZ citizens or permanent residents of Australia and should hold at least Honours 2A or equivalent qualifications. Applicants must be able to commence the PhD and APAI scholarship by 30th June 2009.
